Discipleship:	James, the older of the two apostle sons of Zebedee, whom Jesus nicknamed "sons of thunder," was thirty years old when he became an apostle. He was married, had four children, and lived near his parents in				
	the outskirts of Capernaum. He was a fisherman, plying his calling in company with his younger brother John and in association with Andrew and Simon. James and his brother John enjoyed the advantage of having known Jesus longer than any of the				
Died:	other apostles. James died in AD 44 in Jerusalem and according to the New Testament, he was the second of the apostles to die (after Judas Iscariot), and the first to be martyred. he was put to death with the sword by Herod Agrippa. James is the patron saint of Spain and, according to tradition, what are believed to be his				
Legacy:	remains are held in Santiago de Compostela in Galicia. James lived his life to the full, and when the end came, he bore himself with such grace and fortitude that even his accuser and informer, who attended his trial and execution, was so touched that he rushed away from the scene of James's death to join himself to the disciples of Jesus.
